Chicago Flower & Garden Show returns March 6-14 to Navy Pier
How-to sessions attract do-it-yourselfers, raise funds for charities



The Chicago Flower & Garden Show each year draws residents from Chicago and visitors across the Midwest to learn the newest tips in gardening and landscaping and to see magnificent display gardens. This year's show will be held March 6-14, 2010, on Navy Pier. One of the most popular attractions are "Potting Parties" (above), conducted several times daily—a hands-on seminar on container gardening where "class" members take home their creation to enjoy. The entire proceeds are donated to a designated charity of the day. Show hours are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sundays. Adult admission is \$15 weekdays and \$17 weekends. Tickets for children 4-12 years are \$5 every day.
